THE BURSARY

Who Can Apply?

Any student in Year 6 at MacGregor State School, who will attend MacGregor State High School in 2025, and demonstrates academic and citizenship potential can apply for the Paula Davoren Bursary.

What Does the Bursary Provide?

The recipient of the Paula Davoren Bursary will receive four payments totalling \$5,000 to

their student account over their first four years of high school. The bursary provides the receiving student with \$2,000 in Year 7 to defray the initial costs of transitioning to high school, and \$1,000 per year for Years 8, 9 and 10. The donations of the bursary can be used for both educational expenses as well as uniforms and co-curricular participation. Any funds that are not used within the calendar school year will roll over to the following year.

APPLICATIONS

How Do I Apply?

In 2024, interested students and families will have the opportunity to apply for the Bursary until **4pm Friday 2 August 2024**.

To be considered for the Paula Davoren Bursary Award, families will be required to submit a bursary application. Applicants are asked to supply copies of their two most recent report cards, NAPLAN results, and any other supporting documentation such as ICAS results or certificates of community involvement. A video submission will also be included in the application process, where students put forth their best response to a question posed by the Lion's Club of Brisbane MacGregor, which can be found on the Bursary application form.

How Will Applications Be Assessed?

All applications will be reviewed by a panel of leadership staff from MacGregor State School, MacGregor State High School and Lions Club of Brisbane MacGregor. The accompanying video submissions will be shared with the panel who will determine the response they best believe answers the proposed question. The successful applicant will be selected from the holistic consideration of all aspects of application requirements by the panel. The recipient of the Paula Davoren Bursary will be notified by end of August 2024, with a public acknowledgment at the MacGregor State High School Awards Night in Term 4.
