This funding will be used to achieve

- 75% of students achieving an A & B Achievement Standard in English.
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- 100% of teacher confident in the Australian Curriculum and embedding cross-curricular priorities on School Opinion Survey Data.
- 75% of students in Year 3 achieving in the U2B in NAPLAN for writing.
- 60% of student in Year 5 achieving in the U2B in NAPLAN for writing.
- Differentiated learning is evidenced in teacher planning.
- All students are engaged and challenged in their classroom learning.

- Curriculum, Teaching & Learning Team: Deputy Principal, Head of Curriculums (P-2, 3-6, ICT & Student Services), Classroom Teachers, Support Teachers and Teacher Aides to increase the learning outcomes for students.
- Whole school improvement priorities including: Reading and its relationship to quality writing; Planning and implementing differentiated learning experiences; Investigate and trial innovative teaching and learning strategies.
