Provide relevant education for students- learning and skills set for the future (future focussed learning)  Aligning everything to vision  Build culture and trust in the process  System and structure needs to align to vision, be relevant  Opportunities for students in their learning.</p> <p>Four pillars-  <u>Whole student</u> - what is it like before they walk in?  <u>Education</u>- skills and disposition in learning  <u>Culture</u>- risk taking, challenged, willing to accept feedback and how to they use that feedback.  <u>Partnerships and Connections</u>- how they value add to the education (not necessarily monetary). Worked with PWC to provide corporate thinking.
